A resolution approving an application for an HMIS Development Support grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to the Metropolitan Social Services Commission Homeless Impact Division to pay for software and on-going staff education.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is accepting applications for an HMIS Development Support grant with an award of \$141,508.00 with a required cash match of \$37,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Government is eligible to participate in this grant program; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this grant application be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the application for an HMIS Development Support grant with an award of \$141,508.00, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Metropolitan Social Services Commission Homeless Impact Division is authorized to submit said grant application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution approves an application for a HMIS Development Support grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to the Metropolitan Social Services Homeless Impact Division. If the grant

application is awarded, the grant award would be \$141,508 with a required local cash match of \$37,000. The grant proceeds would be used to pay for software and on-going staff education. The term of the grant would be November 1, 2022 to October 31, 2023.
