An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to negotiate and accept permanent and temporary easements for the Granny Wright Lane Stormwater Improvement Project for two properties located at 2335 and 2337 Granny Wright Lane, (Project No. 20-SWC-64 and Proposal No. 2020M-075ES-001).

WHEREAS, the negotiation and acceptance of permanent and temporary easements for two properties located at 2335 and 2337 Granny Wright Lane are needed to construct MWS Project 20-SWC-64; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2020M-075ES-001 on August 26, 2020, for the negotiation and acceptance of permanent and temporary easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to negotiate and accept permanent and temporary easements for two properties located at 2335 and 2337 Granny Wright Lane, as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the negotiations and acceptance authorized by this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
