A resolution accepting a grant from the Tennessee Department of Health to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to provide HIV/AIDS core medical services and early intervention services.

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee, Department of Health, has awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed \$46,400.00 with no cash match required to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to provide HIV/AIDS core medical services and early intervention services; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the grant by and between the Tennessee Department of Health and the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to provide HIV/AIDS core medical services and early intervention services, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the amount of this grant be appropriated to the Metropolitan Board of Health based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

<u>Analysis</u>

This resolution accepts a grant of \$46,400 from the Tennessee Department of Health to the Metropolitan Board of Health to provide HIV/AIDS core medical services and early intervention services. No local cash match is required. The term of this grant begins April 1, 2022, and ends March 31, 2023.
