WHEREAS, the National Environmental Health Association has awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed \$6,358.00 with no cash match required to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to provide funding for the Food Protection Services Division to attend a NEHA sponsored Self-Assessment and Verification Audit Workshop; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the grant by and between the National Environmental Health Association (NEHA), in an amount not to exceed \$6,358.00, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to provide funding for the Food Protection Services Division to attend a NEHA sponsored Self -Assessment and Verification Audit Workshop, a copy of which grant is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the amount of this grant is to be appropriated to the Metropolitan Department of Health based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan
