An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to accept new public water main, for property located at 5 City Boulevard (MWS Project No. 22-WL-104 and Proposal No. 2023M-006ES-001).

WHEREAS, the acceptance of approximately 46 linear feet of new eight-inch water main (DIP), for property located at 5 City Boulevard, is needed to construct project number 22-WL-104; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2023M-006ES-001 on February 2, 2023, for the acceptance of said water main.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to accept approximately 46 linear feet of new eight-inch water main (DIP), for property located at 5 City Boulevard, as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are

authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the acceptance authorized by this ordinance.

Section 3. Amendments to this legislation shall be approved by resolution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This ordinance accepts approximately 46 linear feet of new eight-inch water main (DIP) for property located at 5 City Boulevard.

Future amendments to this legislation may be approved by resolution. This ordinance has been approved by the Planning Commission.

Fiscal Note: This ordinance has no cost to Metro. Donated easements have no market value according to the Department of Water Services.
