



Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution approves amendment one to a grant from the Friends of Warner Parks to the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation originally approved by RS2022-1675. The grant is used for seasonal staffing for the Special Work Education and Trails (S.W.E.A.T.) program at Warner Parks.

The amendment decreases the grant amount by \$1,545.58, from \$46,252.63 to \$44,707.05 due to the changes recently made to Metro's M&R Worker classifications. The grant will now use the Seasonal Worker 7, Step 3 and Step 5 classifications. There are no other changes to the grant terms. This was approved by the Board of Parks and Recreation at its February 7, 2023 meeting.
