



the problem was at Ms. Todd's property. Ms. Todd hired four plumbing and remediation companies to clean up the damage that accumulated over a three-week period. However, the Metro line was cleaned and began to flow properly on April 6, 2023. Following the cleaning, the sewage backup at Ms. Todd's home was resolved.

Ms. Todd accumulated \$16,074.25 in out-of-pocket expenses to repair the sewer and water damage, along with damage to her garage, bathroom walls, and flooring. The Department of Law recommends settlement of Ms. Todd's property damage claim for \$16,074.25.

*Fiscal Note: This \$16,074.25 settlement, along with the settlements per Resolution Nos. RS2023-2344 and RS2023-2351, would be the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> payments from the Self-Insured Liability Fund in FY24 for a cumulative total of \$58,374. The fund balance would be \$17,599,413 after these payments.*
