



Hickory Boulevard near Larkin Springs Road while performing his job duties. The truck collided with a vehicle driven by Kameron Armstrong while the vehicle was stopped in the left lane of traffic waiting to make a legal U-turn. While the MWS employee applied his brakes, he could not stop the collision. The MWS truck sustained damage from the front right bumper and fender, and Mr. Armstrong's vehicle sustained damage to the entire driver's side and was declared a total loss. During the claims process, Metro previously paid \$13,811.15 to the vehicle's lien holder.

Mr. Armstrong declined an ambulance at the scene of the accident but later sought outpatient treatment for neck, shoulder, and back pain. He was diagnosed with a cervical sprain and treated with muscle relaxers. Mr. Armstrong incurred \$5,408 in medical bills.

The Department of Law recommends the settlement of Mr. Armstrong's personal injury claim for \$10,750.

*Fiscal Note: Metro previously paid \$13,811.15 towards the vehicle's lien holder and the total settlement amount for this resolution is \$10,750. The \$10,750 settlement along with Resolution Nos. RS2024-496 and RS2024-514 would be the 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> payments from the Self-Insured Liability Fund in FY24 for a cumulative total of \$1,592,317. The fund balance would be \$13,763,978 after these payments.*
