



WHEREAS, when service disruptions have occurred, a temporary repair may be made with a permit request and final repairs must be made in accordance with the related permit times and restrictions; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure to investigate enforcement actions to address these concerns related to microtrenching and communication policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Metropolitan Council goes on record as requesting the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure to take the appropriate enforcement actions against fiber franchisees as may be necessary in order to address the issues outlined in this resolution.

Section 2. The Metropolitan Council further requests that, in the event of a service wire being temporarily fastened to the road surface or sidewalk, a permanent subsurface installation must be completed within the terms of the permit. The Council further requests that a failure to comply with the permit timeframe would result in a citation for non-compliance issued.

Section 3. That the Metropolitan Council goes on record as requesting the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure to re-evaluate the Department's existing standard details and specifications and make any and all necessary changes to ensure greater compliance and conformance with local and national standards.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
