



provision of housing services to people experiencing homelessness in Nashville.

Section 2. The Metropolitan Government acting by and through the Office of Homeless Services is hereby authorized to enter into the grant contract, attached hereto and incorporated herein, for the amount provided herein and the purposes stated. Such contract shall specify the terms and conditions under which the grant funds are to be spent.

Section 3 That this Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

#### Analysis

This resolution appropriates a total of \$464,000 from the Office of Homeless Services to The Salvation Army for the provision of housing services to people experiencing homelessness in Nashville.

Pursuant to the terms of the grant contract, The Salvation Army will use the funds to increase the capacity of its LIFNAV Team by providing housing services to those experiencing homelessness in Nashville who are referred by the coordinated entry process. The grant term begins upon the effective date and ends on December 31, 2025, or when funds are depleted, whichever occurs first.
