



WHEREAS, NMAAM broke ground at the 5th + Broad site in early 2017 and had its grand opening in 2020. NMAAM is the only museum dedicated to preserving the legacy and celebrating the accomplishments of the many music genres created, influenced, or inspired by African Americans; and

WHEREAS, this June, NMAAM will commemorate Black Music Month with a calendar of events celebrating the contributions, legacies, and icons of music's past, present, and future; and

WHEREAS, these celebrations include Juke! A Black Country Celebration on June 6, the Bridge to Broadway Block Party on June 16, Juneteenth Community Day on June 19, and more; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the Metropolitan County Council recognize the contribution of African American artists on Nashville's music and culture by celebrating and commemorating Black Music Month.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Metropolitan Council hereby goes on record as recognizing June 2024 as Black Music Month in Nashville and Davidson County and further celebrates the National Museum of African American Music and their events commemorating this historic celebration.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
