WHEREAS, Ms. Langster was also active in her church, St. Ann Catholic Church, and any number of community organizations in Nashville including the Davidson County Democratic Women's Club, the North Nashville Organization for Community Improvement, Top Ladies of Distinction, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., the NAACP, and was a former member of the Nashville Symphony Board; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Langster is survived by her two adult children, one brother, and five grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the Metropolitan Council recognize the life of Edith Taylor Langster and her great contributions to Nashville and Davidson County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Metropolitan County Council hereby goes on record as honoring the life and legacy of Ms. Edith Taylor Langster.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
