NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Metropolitan County Council hereby recognizes the month of September as Childhood Cancer Awareness Month in recognition of the importance of raising awareness, supporting families affected by this disease, and fostering a sense of hope for a future where every child diagnosed with cancer can live a long, healthy life.

Section 2. That the Metropolitan Council further encourages the citizens of Nashville and Davidson County to participate in activities and events throughout the month of September that honor and support children battling cancer, advocate for continued research and advancements in treatment, and extend compassion to all affected by childhood cancer.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
