NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Council hereby goes on record as recognizing September 15 to October 15, 2024, as Hispanic Heritage Month in Nashville and Davidson County to honor the many accomplishments and contributions made by members of the Hispanic community, and to encourage all residents to celebrate and support the people and businesses that make Nashville a unique and wonderful city.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
