A resolution approving amendment seven to a grant from the Tennessee Department of Health to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to improve the health of those residing in or visiting Davidson County through targeted strategies to prevent and control the use of tobacco products.

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, previously entered into a grant agreement with the Tennessee Department of Health, to improve the health of those residing in or visiting Davidson County through targeted strategies to prevent and control the use of tobacco products approved by RS2018-1305; and,

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the grant agreement to increase the amount of the grant by \$140,000.00 from \$629,900.00 to \$769,900.00, a copy of which amendment seven is attached hereto; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that amendment seven be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That amendment seven to the grant by and between the Tennessee Department of Health and the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to improve the health of those residing in or visiting Davidson County through targeted strategies to prevent and control the use of tobacco products, a copy of which amendment seven is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Metropolitan Mayor is authorized to execute the same.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution approves the seventh amendment to a grant from the Tennessee Department of Health to the Metropolitan Board of Health, originally approved by Resolution No. RS2018-1305. This grant provides funding to improve the health of those residing in or visiting Davidson County through targeted strategies to prevent and control the use of tobacco products. This grant contract is a continuation of the Tobacco Master Settlement Letter of Agreement dated February 1, 2014. The term of this grant began on July 1, 2018 and extends until June 30, 2023.

This amendment increases the grant amount by \$140,000, from \$629,900 to \$769,900.
