

Metropolitan Nashville and Davidson County, TN

An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to abandon existing public water main, and to accept new public water main, for property located at 1 Terminal Drive, also known as Sky Harbour Hangers, (MWS Project No. 22-WL-96 and Proposal No. 2022M-139ES-001).

WHEREAS, the abandonment of approximately 14 linear feet of existing 12 inch water main, and the acceptance of approximately 14 linear feet of new 12 inch water main (DIP), for property located at 1 Terminal Drive, also known as Sky Harbour Hangers, are needed to construct project number 22-WL-96; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2022M-139ES-001 on September 18, 2022, for the abandonment and acceptance of said water mains.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to abandon approximately 14 linear feet of existing 12 inch water main, and to accept approximately 14 linear feet of new 12 inch water main (DIP), for property located at 1 Terminal Drive, also known as Sky Harbour Hangers, as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the abandonment and acceptance authorized by this ordinance.

Section 3. Amendments to this legislation shall be approved by resolution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

<u>Analysis</u>

This ordinance abandons approximately 14 linear feet of existing 12-inch water main, and accepts approximately 14 linear feet of new 12-inch water main (DIP) for property located at 1 Terminal Drive, also known as Sky Harbour Hangers.

Future amendments to this legislation may be approved by resolution. This ordinance has been approved by the Planning Commission.

Fiscal Note: This ordinance has no cost to Metro. Donated and abandoned easements have no market value according to the Department of Water Services.
