A resolution accepting an in-kind grant from the West Nashville Sports League to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, for new fencing, gates, scoreboards, and infield work on baseball fields, 1 and 2, and additional fencing and gates on baseball fields 3, 4, and 5 in Warner Park.

WHEREAS, the West Nashville Sports League has awarded an in-kind grant, with an estimated value of \$27,500.00 with no cash match required, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, for new fencing, gates, scoreboards, and infield work on baseball fields, 1 and 2, and additional fencing and gates on baseball fields 3, 4, and 5 in Warner Park; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this in-kind grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the in-kind grant by and between the West Nashville Sports League, with an estimated value of \$27,500.00, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, for new fencing, gates, scoreboards, and infield work on baseball fields, 1 and 2, and additional fencing and gates on baseball fields 3, 4, and 5 in Warner Park, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That this in-kind grant be appropriated to the Metro Nashville Parks Department based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution accepts an in-kind grant from the West Nashville Sports League to the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation with an estimated value of \$27,500 and no cash match required. The in-kind grant is for new fencing, gates, scoreboards, and infield work on baseball fields 1 and 2 and additional fencing and gates on baseball fields 3, 4, and 5 in Warner Park. This was approved by the Board of Parks and Recreation at its March 7, 2023, meeting.
