

Metropolitan Nashville and Davidson County, TN

An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to accept new public sanitary sewer main, sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for two properties located at Old Hickory Boulevard (unnumbered) and Windypine Drive (unnumbered) (MWS Project No. 23-SL-08 and Proposal No. 2023M-094ES-001).

WHEREAS, the acceptance of approximately 879 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), five sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for two properties located at Old Hickory Boulevard (unnumbered) and Windypine Drive (unnumbered), is needed to construct project number 23-SL-08; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2023M-094ES-001 on June 20, 2023, for the acceptance of said sanitary sewer main, sanitary sewer manholes and easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to accept approximately 879 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), five sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for two properties located at Old Hickory Boulevard (unnumbered) and Windypine Drive (unnumbered), as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the acceptance authorized by this ordinance.

Section 3. Amendments to this legislation shall be approved by resolution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

<u>Analysis</u>

This ordinance accepts approximately 879 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer (PVC), five sanitary sewer manholes, and easements for two properties located at Old Hickory Boulevard (unnumbered) and Windypine Drive (unnumbered).

Future amendments to this legislation may be approved by resolution. This ordinance has been approved by the Planning Commission.

Fiscal Note: This ordinance has no cost to Metro. Donated easements have no market value according to the Department of Water Services.
