A resolution recognizing the Donelson Christian Academy Wildcats football team on a successful season.

WHEREAS, the Donelson Christian Academy Wildcats football team concluded their season on November 23rd with a loss to Columbia Academy in the TSSAA Division II Class A State Playoff Semifinals; and

WHEREAS, the Wildcats finished the season with an overall record of 10-3; and

WHEREAS, the Wildcats were led by first year football coach and Donelson Christian Academy alumni Jay Pierce; and

WHEREAS, the team stat leaders were: QB Mitchell Carey (2685 total yards, 8 touchdowns), Grayson Scragg (1121 receiving yards, 20 touchdowns) and King Gardner (1250 rushing yards, 13 touchdowns); and

WHEREAS, Donelson Christian Academy has been an integral part of the Donelson-Hermitage community since its founding in 1971; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the Metropolitan Council congratulates the Donelson Christian Academy Wildcats football team for a season filled with accomplishments of which the surrounding community is extremely proud.
