A resolution accepting an in-kind grant from the Sylvan Park Neighborhood Association to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, to replace the existing Sylvan Park neighborhood sign in Richland Park.

WHEREAS, the Sylvan Park Neighborhood Association has awarded an in-kind grant with an estimated value of \$16,575 with no cash match required to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, to replace the existing Sylvan Park neighborhood sign in Richland Park; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this in-kind grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the in-kind grant by and between the Sylvan Park Neighborhood Association, with an estimated value of \$16,575, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, to replace the existing Sylvan Park neighborhood sign in Richland Park, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That this in-kind grant be appropriated to the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution accepts an in-kind grant from the Sylvan Park Neighborhood Association to the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation to replace the existing Sylvan Park neighborhood sign in Richland Park. The proposed sign would replace an existing sign at the corner of 46th Avenue North and Park Avenue.

The in-kind grant has an estimated value of \$16,575. Installation of the sign would be paid entirely by the Sylvan Park Neighborhood Association. No funds will be coming to the Metropolitan Government related to this grant. This grant was approved by the Board of Parks and Recreation at its January 7, 2025, meeting.
