A resolution accepting an in-kind grant from the Centennial Park Conservancy to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, to fund updating the current Concept Plan depicting improvements made to date and the current vision for future revitalization phases for Centennial Park.

WHEREAS, the Centennial Park Conservancy has awarded an in-kind grant in an amount not to exceed \$82,135 with no cash match required to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, to fund updating the current Concept Plan depicting improvements made to date and the current vision for future revitalization phases for Centennial Park; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this in-kind grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the in-kind grant by and between the Centennial Park Conservancy, in an amount not to exceed \$82,135, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, to fund updating the current Concept Plan depicting improvements made to date and the current vision for future revitalization phases for Centennial Park, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That this in-kind grant be appropriated to the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

The Centennial Park Master Plan is a public-private partnership between Metro Parks and Centennial Park Conservancy. Established in 2010, this multi-decade transformation of our city's central park is ensuring this historic greenspace remains a vibrant destination for current and future generations. The current Concept Plan was created in 2015, and the revitalization project team believes it's an appropriate time for an updated plan depicting the improvements that have been made to date and the current vision for future revitalization phases.


