On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the abandonment of approximately 28 linear feet of eight-inch water main and the acceptance of approximately 28 linear feet of new eight-inch water main (DIP), for the purpose of vertical realignment due to a conflict with the proposed sanitary sewer service, to serve the 450-460 James Robertson Parkway Water Main Realignment.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Nashville Department of Transportation, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, General ServicesPublic Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval. This request must be approved by the Metro Council to become effective. A sketch showing the location of the request is attached to this letter.
