**Re: Nolensville Town Square Revision 1  
Planning Commission Mandatory Referral 2025M-166ES-002  
Council District # Williamson County, Council Member**

On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

*A request to amend Council Ordinance BL2025-905 and Proposal No. 2025M-166ES-001 for the purpose of accepting approximately 300 fewer linear feet of six-inch sanitary sewer force main (DIP) to serve the Nolensville Town Square – Revision 1 development. Specific infrastructure for Project No. 24-SL-83 is now the acceptance of approximately 1,852 linear feet of six-inch sanitary sewer force main (DIP), 405 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), 3,629 linear feet of eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), 32 sanitary sewer manholes, 1 sanitary sewer pump station and easements.*

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Nashville Department of Transportation, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, General Services-Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval. This request must be approved by the Metro Council to become effective. A sketch showing the location of the request is attached to this letter.
